



Resolution from the Republicans for National Renewal on Election Integrity

Summary: Over the past two election cycles, whistleblowers for election integrity have been proven undeniably right. In 2020, ballots were trafficked in by Democrat operatives in corrupt inner city fraud centers to swing the result to illegitimate figurehead Joe Biden. Republicans refused to listen to whistleblowers, causing many of the same problems to occur in the 2022 midterm elections. Polls show that an overwhelming majority of Americans no longer trust the electoral process. Republicans must lead with major reforms to unite the public and ensure that every American's voice is heard when they cast their ballot for elections.

Whereas the 2020 election saw systemic and coordinated fraud with Donald Trump being blatantly defrauded out of the election.

Whereas in 2019, the Brennan Center gave testimony to the House Committee on Science, Space, and Technology. This testimony included the need to replace paperless voting systems, adding electronic poll books to the Federal certificate process, conduct penetration testing and nationwide threat assessments of the nation's election infrastructure, requiring election system vendors to report cyber incidents, requiring the National Institute of Standards and Technology to create an Election Profile to guide adoption of the security framework nationwide for elections infrastructure, and illustrated the need to provide additional funding state and local election officials to secure election systems nationwide (4-Brennan Center for Justice);

Whereas all of these recommendations were ignored and election systems would be made even more vulnerable before the 2020 election, by design, in order to facilitate the planned coup ouster of Donald Trump;

Whereas in 2020, many states rolled out widespread mail in ballots for the first time, which were not properly verified by election officials. Many ballots and voter registrations sent out in 2020 and beyond were found out after the fact to not meet adequate voter ID requirements. Mail in ballots have a higher rejection rate with as many a 20% are rejected due to a combination of either wrong/bad signatures, not complying with the rules/regulations, and other issues. This number fell drastically as standards were lessened as part of the election fraud blueprint. (1-Heritage Foundation).

Whereas this process has disenfranchised legitimate voters from voting and increases the potential for abuse can exist as well. Any mail in ballot system must be carefully thought out, carefully rolled out, have safeguards and strong standards, with a strong auditing system to ensure election integrity, something that did not occur in 2020;

Whereas corporate America worked with left wing activists in the lead up to the 2020 presidential election and beyond in order to “fortify” the results against Trump (3-Time Magazine), this agreement was the consequence of an unofficial partnership between powerful businesspeople, government officials and left-wing campaigners;

Whereas this illicit agreement was formalized in a brief, little noticed joint statement released on 2020 election day by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce and AFL-CIO. Both sides released this statement as the admission of a implicit contract where the powers of corporate America and the activist left came together to undermine the will of mainstream Americans, prevent nationalism, and continue the national decline of the country as planned by the globalists. This Devil’s bargain was facilitated by the summer's large-scale, occasionally destructive BLM marches;

Whereas in 2020; poll challengers were criminally impeded in the absentee ballot counting event at absentee voting processing facilities in Detroit, Philadelphia, Atlanta, Milwaukee, and elsewhere. Poll challengers were falsely accused of being disorderly and harassed in coordinated fashion on the basis of Covid-related "social distancing" rules and were trained to use this process in order to disenfranchise the constitutional rights of challengers (2-Michigan);

Whereas Dominion Voting Systems, in a state that is considered a competitive one and where hundreds of independent observers claim to have seen vote rigging taking place on election night, attorneys hired by Dominion voting systems have sent at least one intimidating letter with a list of demands to an individual who has come forward to report electoral fraud;

Whereas original reporting shows that intimidating letters were sent to whistleblowers nationwide in the aftermath of the stolen 2020 presidential election. Dominion Voting Systems used this lawfare in order to put the whistleblowers on notice and make them feel like they were committing a crime by speaking out on the fraud they witnessed first hand on election day, adding to

the chilling effect and the culture of terror being inflicted on those who were speaking out (5-Big League Politics);

Whereas many in the Uniparty establishment and deep state were hostile against whistleblowers as well, showing how the system worked in coordinated fashion to enforce the 2020 election steal. Sen. Jeanne Shaheen (D-NH) made an appearance on CNN to accuse supporters of electoral accountability and openness of committing "sedition and treason," adding that "these senators and members of Congress who have refused to acknowledge that we had a free and fair election in which Joe Biden beat Donald Trump by over 7 million votes, are bordering on sedition and treason," she said (6-Big League Politics);

Whereas Michigan Attorney General Dana Nessel, a far-left progressive Democrat, told election whistleblowers that so called "false" claims about election fraud were criminal acts (8-The Hill), also adding to the culture of intimidation against whistleblowers and suppressing inquiry into fraud that was witnessed by hundreds of credible observers;

Whereas the Attorneys fees for Facebook, Dominion Voting Systems, the states of Michigan, Pennsylvania, Georgia, and Wisconsin, as well as the nonprofit Center for Tech and Civic Life, who were all named as defendants in the lawsuit, must now be paid by Gary D. Fielder and Ernest John Walker, who filed the election lawsuit in late December 2020 in federal court in Colorado (9-CNN). This amounts to intimidation against lawyers and whistleblowers, sending a message to other lawyers not to take cases and whistleblowers not to speak out unless be crushed by extreme repression;

Whereas over 100 attorneys who worked on former President Trump's post-election lawsuits are apparently being targeted by a dark money organization with ties to the Democratic Party. The 65 Project, named after the 65 lawsuits filed to reverse the 2020 election results, has already filed 10 ethics complaints as part of their scheme and are airing advertising in contested areas. This group was set to spend millions to target 111 attorneys in 26 states who are acting on behalf of whistleblowers. David Brock, who is advising this group, said the purpose of the organization is "not only bring the grievances in the bar complaints, but shame them and make them toxic in their communities and in their firms." (10-Hill). This

group has the aim of removing the bar licenses of these 111 attorneys and to make their lives as miserable as possible;

Whereas the U.S. Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Agency, or CISA said in 2022 that electronic voting machines from a leading vendor used in at least 16 states have software vulnerabilities that leave them susceptible to hacking if unaddressed, according to their advisory sent to state election officials. (11-AP). A report was written by University of Michigan computer scientist J. Alex Halderman, who has long argued that using digital technology to record votes is risky because computers are inherently vulnerable to hacking and require many safeguards that are rarely followed. Halderman supports the use of hand-marked paper ballots and stated that these “vulnerabilities...could be exploited by sophisticated attackers, such as hostile nation states, or by election insiders, and they would carry very serious consequences.” According to Halderman, the most significant flaws might make it possible for malicious code to migrate from the election management system to devices across an entire jurisdiction. If election workers utilize USB sticks to transfer data from an infected device into the election management system, the vulnerability could be exploited by someone with physical access to the system or by someone who is able to remotely infect other computers that are linked to the internet;

Whereas, Halderman concluded that “there are systemic problems with the way election equipment is developed, tested and certified, and I think it’s more likely than not that serious problems would be found in equipment from other vendors if they were subjected to the same kind of testing,” Halderman also tested machines used in Georgia, and he said it could be possible that machines running other versions of the software could share the same vulnerabilities (11-AP);

Whereas, Halderman said that, as far as he knows, “no one but Dominion has had the opportunity to test their asserted fixes.” According to Halderman, there are several additional vulnerabilities that are particularly concerning since they allow an attacker access to a system so they can update the software by forging cards that technicians use in the machines. Attackers can then modify recorded votes,

mark ballots differently than voters intended, or even recognize voters' secret ballots, according to Halderman's analysis (11-AP);

Whereas evidence emerged following the election that served as a smoking gun showing how coordinated fraud was used to impact the result. After everyone else had been sent home for the evening under false pretenses, shocking video from a Georgia Senate Hearing on Election Integrity showed poll workers retrieving and tallying suitcases of ballots that were stashed under a table. At Atlanta's State Farm Arena, a surveillance camera captured the footage. Around 10:30 p.m., poll workers vacated the space, with Republican poll observers and a Fox News crew being the last to go. According to signed testimony, those who left believed that counting had ended for the evening and that they could return at 8:30 the next morning. However, four poll workers remained. They hauled out four suitcases filled with uncounted ballots from under a table at 11:00 p.m. after waiting for about a half-hour. On Election Day, a woman with braided blonde hair who also urged everyone to leave by 10:30 p.m. placed the disputed table there at 8:22 a.m. In fact, two witnesses learned from the media a few hours later that the four poll workers had continued to count votes. Though the poll workers had finished counting and scanning the secret ballots at 1:00am, they returned to State Farm Arena between 1:30 and 1:45am (12- Big League Politics). This should have been thoroughly investigated by multiple agencies at a local, state, federal, public, and private level to achieve accountability, jail the fraud actors and discover the conspiracy behind the actions;

Whereas additional Georgians questioned the validity of a large number of absentee ballots from the 2020 election that, according to expert testimony, appeared to be identical copies of Xerox opened and using identical paper and ink. Fulton County polling official Suzi Voyles had never seen anything like this in her 20 years of observing and administering Fulton County elections. "It's all eerily pristine," she noted. She noticed the difference while sorting through a large stack of mail-in ballots in November 2020. Flipping through the ballots, she saw that some of the votes chosen for Joe Biden were eerily similar on paper and ink. The ballots were identical in nature with fully filled ovals. Each bubble had an identical white space inside shaped like a small crescent. According to " Real Clear

Investigations”, the dark ovals appear to have been copied rather than filled in with a pen or pencil (13-BPR).

Having tediously detailed the nefarious actions that were taken and occurred throughout the 2020 presidential election and then yet again in the 2022 midterm elections, we solidly endorse the following measures to counteract election fraud in the future and ensure election integrity:

- (1) Independent and thorough audits of all elections to ensure election integrity.
- (2) Code in the software used in voting machines is made transparent to the public to ensure there are no flaws/exploits in the voting machines.
- (3) Live video on workers in ballot counting centers for accountability that can be analyzed by the public as a bulwark against potential rule-breaking.
- (4) Voting machines need to produce receipt tapes at the end of the elections without exception. These results can be transmitted by text message, texted photos, phoned in, or simply delivered to the clerk's office. There is no reason any voting machine should transmit results to a receiving board electronically.
- (5) Strict Voter ID laws will ensure the integrity of every mail-in ballot, with no mail-in ballots allowed without an ID and no more than one per individual. One voter, one ballot, without exceptions with watermarks and technological innovations used to secure ballots.
- (6) Absentee ballot status is a public record that is routinely obtained by campaigns during the "absentee chase" period of a campaign. Clerks keep daily records of absentee ballots as they receive them. This public information should be required to be accessible to the public, so voters can confirm that their absentee ballots are received.
- (7) Equality for poll workers in terms of access, transparency, and rights regarding vote tabulation stations and entire voting process. Allowing all poll workers to verify integrity at all steps of the process, without exceptions or any emergency provisions. All poll workers and election

officials must be trained diligently to know the rights of poll challengers and will be criminally charged if those rights are impeded.

- (8) Require a clear and consistent signature check policy. The Secretary of State should be required to issue a uniform signature verification standard that may not be changed during election season, to be applied in all aspects of elections – absentee ballot applications, absentee ballot envelopes, applications to vote, and petitions – and for this standard to be made available to the public.
- (9) When election crimes are committed, it is critical for witnesses to be able to identify the individuals involved. Ballot inspectors and other election workers should be required to wear name tags always identifying them by first and last name in public proceedings, and failure to do so should be a misdemeanor criminal act.
