

Resolution for the Acquisition and Integration of Greenland into the United States

Summary

The acquisition and integration of Greenland into the United States would significantly enhance America's Arctic presence and capabilities. This integration would enable the expansion of critical military installations like Pituffik Space Base, facilitate the responsible development of vast mineral resources, including rare earth elements, and strengthen America's position in emerging Arctic shipping routes. Resolution

WHEREAS, the United States recognizes the strategic importance of Greenland in the rapidly changing Arctic region^{[3][19]};

WHEREAS, Denmark's limited capabilities hinder Greenland's potential for growth, security, and development^[13];

WHEREAS, the United States possesses the resources, capabilities, and strategic interest to fully develop and protect Greenland^{[4][12]};

WHEREAS, the United States must initiate diplomatic negotiations with the Kingdom of Denmark and the autonomous government of Greenland to transfer full sovereignty and control of Greenland to the United States^{[1][6]};

WHEREAS, upon successful negotiation, the United States shall integrate Greenland as a territory, with provisions for future statehood to be determined^[14];

WHEREAS, the United States shall immediately enhance military presence and capabilities in Greenland, upgrading existing facilities and establishing new ones to ensure Arctic security and early warning systems against potential threats^[4]^[19];

WHEREAS, a comprehensive plan shall be developed to responsibly utilize Greenland's vast natural resources, including rare earth elements, uranium, oil, and gas, to benefit both Greenland's local population and the broader United States economy^[2]^[10]^[16];

WHEREAS, the United States shall invest in and develop Greenland's infrastructure, including ports, airports, and telecommunications, to support economic growth and improve the quality of life for Greenland's residents^[8]^[15].

WHEREAS, Pituffik Space Base shall be expanded and modernized to enhance U.S. space surveillance and missile defense capabilities^[4]^[12].

WHEREAS, a robust scientific research program shall be established to leverage Greenland's unique position for climate and environmental studies, promoting U.S. leadership in Arctic research^[7]^[11].

WHEREAS, the United States shall develop policies to protect and preserve Greenland's indigenous culture while integrating the territory into the broader American framework^[8]^[15].

WHEREAS, a strategy shall be implemented to position the United States as the preeminent Arctic power, leveraging Greenland's location to secure new shipping routes and counter Russian and Chinese influence in the region^[3]^[19].

WHEREAS, the United States shall establish programs to develop and secure critical mineral supplies from Greenland, reducing dependence on foreign sources and enhancing national security^[2]^[10]^[18].

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the United States affirms its commitment to strengthening its Arctic presence, ensuring national security, and responsibly developing Greenland's potential in ways that Denmark is unable to match;
