

Resolution for the Acquisition and Integration of Greenland into the United States

Introduction: The United States has long recognized the strategic value of Greenland in maintaining national security and advancing American interests in the Arctic region. As global competition for Arctic resources and influence intensifies, particularly from Russia and China, the current administrative arrangement under Danish sovereignty fails to fully realize Greenland's potential. While Denmark has been a reliable NATO ally, its limited economic and military capabilities prevent the full development of Greenland's strategic, economic, and scientific potential. The integration of Greenland into the United States framework would serve both American national interests and the developmental aspirations of Greenland's population.
